R.M. OF MOUNTAIN VIEW NO. 318

2013 PIPELINE/ROAD CROSSING POLICY

- 1. All road allowances are deemed to be 45.72 meters or 150 feet in width.
- 2. All pipelines must be installed between 45 and 90 degree angles to the road allowance on all developed roads.
- 3. Pipelines must cross road allowances at the low spots where possible.
- 4. Minimum pipeline depth shall be 1.5 meters below the ditch and 2.0 meters below the road surface.
- 5. All municipal roads/road allowances must be bored through.
- 6. When the work is complete, the road must be leveled off and left in its original condition.
- 7. Plans of completed pipeline crossing must be provided to the municipality for use in future roadwork.
- 8. The applicant/developer and/or their successor shall now and in the future indemnify and save harmless the Rural Municipality of Mountain View No. 318, its agents, employees or any person legally empowered by the municipality from any and all liabilities, environmental damages, costs, claims, suits or actions arising out of the approval hereby granted, to the extent that the said liabilities, environmental damages, costs, claims, suits or actions are not the result of the Rural Municipality of Mountain View No. 318, its agents or employees negligence or willful misconduct.
- 9. If future roadwork is required at this crossing site it is understood and agreed that the pipeline will be lowered at no cost to the municipality.
- 10. All pipeline markers on any road allowance must be 40 feet apart to freely allow travel by large equipment.
- 11. No road closures will be allowed without the prior permission of the council or administrator. Daily fines of \$250.00 will be charged if there are any infractions regarding road closure.
- 12. In order to prevent the spread of clubroot disease of canola and mustard, all equipment entering the R.M. of Mountain View No. 318 from outside of the municipal boundaries is to be thoroughly washed before crossing the border into the R.M. of Mountain View No. 318.
